





PROJECT SPOTLIGHT: Charles Schwab Building Renovation Tucson, AZ

This Charles Schwab building in Tucson, Arizona, is a striking example of the transformative power of innovative design. This 1975 structure has been dramatically reshaped to pair functionality with a captivating aesthetic with the use of Steelscape's Vintage[®] coated metal.
